Update from the Directrice

- Next week the reports and presentations from students in classes

- April 5th – Movie Night – 2 movies avec la Societe Culturelle Francophone – one for kids/families and one for teens/adults, in the Chatelech theatre
- Grade 12 Graduation is May 31st, Graduation is at SFU + Cruise in the Harbour
- April 30th-May 1st – Leadership Camp for Grade 8s – with the CSF, organized by the Conseil Jeunesse Francophone

Music Lessons
